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The School: Founded in 1869, Stoneleigh-Burnham is an independent college preparatory school for girls. Students are admitted to grades 7-12 and postgraduate. Stoneleigh-Burnham School welcomes students from across the country and around the world. We have more than 150 day and boarding students from 13 countries and 15 states. Many of our faculty members hold advanced degrees. Class size is usually between 10-12, with a student/teacher ratio of approximately 6:1. We are the only girls' school in New England to offer the IB. Offering the IB affords us the opportunity to provide a global, interdisciplinary curriculum and to apply international assessment standards.

Our Mission: Stoneleigh-Burnham School is an academic community that fosters an international perspective. We inspire girls to pursue meaningful lives

based on honor, respect and intellectual curiosity. Each student is challenged to discover her best self and graduate with confidence to think independently and act ethically, secure in the knowledge that her voice will be heard.

Our Programs: Stoneleigh-Burnham School features signature Dance, Debate, and Equestrian programs. We require community service participation in our Middle School and through our International Baccalaureate (IB) program for juniors and seniors. Our Academic Center offers students support in developing the skills and strategies necessary to succeed in an unmodified college-preparatory curriculum. International exchange programs are available.

Our Curriculum: Graduation requirements include 20 credits with the following course distribution:

- English:** 4 years required
- Mathematics:** 4 years required including Algebra 2
- History:** 3 years required including United States History
- Science:** 3 years required, 2 years of lab science
- Foreign Languages:** 3 years of the same language required, 4 years recommended
- Arts:** 2 trimesters of art per year
- Athletics:** each trimester while enrolled
- English Language:** Advanced EL

Students are enrolled in five or more courses per trimester, including art. IB courses for IB credit entail two years of study. Students may take one year of an IB course for SBS credit. Please visit our website at sbschool.org for

further details about course descriptions. All students participate in athletics every trimester (including many Saturdays) and so are scheduled from 8:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. most days, with clubs meeting at night, followed by evening study hall.

Grading: Grading at Stoneleigh-Burnham follows a traditional A-F descending order pattern with the following numerical correspondents: A: 90-100, B: 80-89, C: 70-79, D: 60-69, F Below 60, P: Pass, F: Fail. D-(60) is the lowest passing grade. Grades are unweighted. Stoneleigh-Burnham does not establish class rank.
