- ✓ English Language Program (EL) classes are an integral part of the life of some Stoneleigh-Burnham international students and are available for those students whom the School believes will benefit. A credit will be applied if it is determined the student does not need EL classes.
- ✓ International students receive specialized orientation, forms processing, individualized college advisory, special activities and the school serves as a liaison with families and agents.
- ✓ On-campus weekend activities and entertainment for students are provided throughout the year. Tickets and transportation to off-campus events, movies, shopping, etc., are charges incurred by each student, as would be the case for students at home. Yearbooks are provided to all students.
- ✓ The Technology Department provides access to a dorm wireless network with time limits by grade level. Computers are available in the library and labs for academic use. Students are required to use school-provided virus protection on personal computers. Limited troubleshooting is provided by the Technology Department, but computer repairs are the responsibility of the family. All students are required to own a personal iPad for in-class use.
- ✓ The School has a state-certified infirmary staffed by a registered nurse. A school physician is on call twenty-four hours a day. Medications, private doctors' bills and hospitalization are **not** covered by the School. These costs are covered under student's U.S.-based health insurance plan purchased through the School.
- ✓ The International Student Accident and Health Insurance Plan is required of all international students unless alternate coverage by a U.S. insurance company is provided. In order to insure timely and proper health care in the event of injury or illness, this plan offers excellent comprehensive coverage. The policy covers the school year from August 20th through June 19th.
- ✓ Dorm Room Security Deposit of \$100 covers damages to the room above normal wear and tear and is returned at the end of the school year if there are no damages or extra cleaning required.

Equestrian Program Fees

The SBS equestrian facilities are open to all students. The School provides boarding of privately-owned horses at \$750.00 per month. The School also has 25-30 school-owned horses available for leasing by individual students for a fee of \$2,500.00 per trimester. Stall deposit of \$500.00 required. Boarding and leasing fees include a box stall, turnout, daily care and feeding. Lessee is responsible for minor vet care and clipping. Grooming services during vacation and the school year are available at additional cost.

Riding Lessons are available for the beginner, intermediate, and advanced rider. Lesson fees are determined by the number of lessons taken per week per trimester, and whether taken privately or as part of a group. The additional fees for Horse Shows (entry fees, vaning, accommodations, etc.) are determined prior to each event. A hard hat with a chin harness is required of all riders.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES AND BILLING PROCEDURES

Parents will receive a monthly tuition statement with itemized tuition and fees. Balances are due and payable when statements are received. A late charge of 1.5% will accrue on any balance more than 30 days past due.

Each student also maintains a separate debit account (Smart Account) in the school store with an initial deposit of for \$1,000.00 for e-books, textbooks and incidental expenses incurred throughout the year. Funds must be in the accounts for students to cover cash withdrawals and student purchases, including e-books and textbooks.
