

## SCHEDULE OF TUITION PLANS AND FEES 2018-2019 ACADEMIC YEAR

**Tuition** is \$59,939 for Boarding Students and \$35,096 for Day Students. Tuition may be paid in one of three ways, as listed below. The non-refundable enrollment deposit equal to 10% of net tuition (\$1,500 minimum) must be returned with the signed Enrollment Agreement.

\* The **Health Center Fee** covers your daughter's health needs while at School. We have a state-certified infirmary, staffed by a registered nurse and a physician who is on call twenty-four hours a day. Medications, private doctors' bills, and hospitalization are not covered by the Health Center Fee. Those costs must be covered under the student's U.S.-based medical health insurance plan, purchased privately or through the school. Fees for transportation and accompanying to medical office visits are billed separately.

\*\* The **Activity Fee** covers on-campus weekend activities and entertainment for all students throughout the year. Tickets and transportation to off-campus events, movies, shopping, etc., are charges incurred by each student, as would be the case at home for all students. Yearbooks are provided to all students.

\*\*\* The **Technology Fee** provides access to a dorm wireless network with time limits by grade level. Computers are available in the library and labs for academic use. Students are required to use school-provided virus protection on personal computers. Limited troubleshooting is provided by the Tech Department, but computer repairs are the responsibility of the family. All students are required to own a personal iPad for in class use.

\*\*\*\* The **Dorm Room Security Deposit** covers damages to the room above normal wear and tear and is returned at the end of the school year if there are no damages or extra cleaning required.

## OPTIONAL COURSE AND SERVICE FEES

The fees listed below are incurred only if a student participates in a particular course or receives services.

### UPPER SCHOOL ONLY:

- International Baccalaureate Fees (estimated based on 2017)
  - Registration Fee \$ 168.00
  - Subject Exam Fee \$ 116.00 (per subject)
- Lab Science Fee \$ 65.00 (full year)
- British Horse Society \$ 500.00 (per trimester)
- Visual Art Fees (based on course and materials used) \$ 65.00 – 125.00 (per trimester)

### MIDDLE SCHOOL AND UPPER SCHOOL:

- Performing Arts Fees \$ 65.00 (per trimester)
- Private Music Instruction \$ 40.00 (per lesson)

### ***Equestrian Program Fees***

The SBS equestrian facilities are open to all students. The School provides boarding of privately-owned horses at \$750.00 per month. The School also has 25-30 school-owned horses available for leasing by individual students for a fee of \$2,500.00 per trimester. Stall deposit of \$500.00 required. Boarding and leasing fees include a box stall, turnout, daily care and feeding. Lessee is responsible for minor vet care and clipping. Grooming services during vacation and the school year are available at additional cost.

***Riding Lessons*** are available for the beginner, intermediate, and advanced rider. Lesson fees are determined by the number of lessons taken per week per trimester, and whether taken privately or as part of a group. The additional fees for Horse Shows (entry fees, vaning, accommodations, etc.) are determined prior to each event. A hard hat with a chin harness is required of all riders.

#### Lesson Fees

- *Group Lesson*
  - Three lessons per week \$ 1,350.00 (per trimester)\*
  - Four lessons per week \$ 1,680.00 (per trimester)\*
- *Private Lesson*
  - ½ hour per week \$ 800.00 (per trimester)

(Recommendation required from SBS trainer on an as-needed basis)

## MISCELLANEOUS NOTES AND BILLING PROCEDURES

Parents will receive a monthly tuition statement with itemized tuition and fees. Balances are due and payable when statements are received. A late charge of 1.5% will accrue on any balance more than 30 days past due.

Each student also maintains a separate debit account (Smart Account) in the school store with an initial deposit of \$250 for day students and \$1,000 for boarding students to cover e-books, textbooks and incidental expenses incurred throughout the year. Funds must be in the account for students to cover cash withdrawals and store purchases, including e-books and textbooks.
