



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Your nonrefundable deposit must be received by the due date specified on your enrollment agreement. Your enrollment is not considered final until this has been received.

If the signed enrollment agreement and deposit are not received by the due date, the student will not be enrolled and her spot may be forfeited.

By signing this enrollment agreement, you are acknowledging that you agree to pay the full academic year's amount of tuition, fees, and expenses of the student. The school will not refund nor reduce any part of tuition and/or fees due to a student's dismissal, withdrawal, or absence either before or during the school year. See information on the Tuition Refund Plan below.

If we have not received your full financial aid application, we may have included an estimate of your financial aid award. We cannot guarantee this offer beyond the deadline date for returned agreements. After that date, the funds will be released for incoming students with need.

Tuition Refund Plan

SBS offers the Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) through the Dewar Insurance Company. The TRP premium is calculated at 3.7% of the net tuition. This plan will pay 50% of the prorated tuition for the student in case of dismissal or withdrawal after the first 14 days of the school year. This plan is required for all students who are not fully paid by July 1st. Parents who pay the full tuition amount by July 1st may choose to opt out of the TRP plan by signing a waiver. *If the waiver is not received, you will be automatically enrolled and charged for the plan.*

Stoneleigh-Burnham Statements

Parents will receive monthly statements from SBS. Balances are due at the time of receipt. Please contact the Business Office to discuss if you are not able to pay immediately.

Any student carrying a balance past 30 days may be prevented from participating in sports, classes, school events, etc.

Previous trimester riding charges must be fully paid before the student can sign up for the next trimester.

All tuition accounts must be paid in full before a student's senior year. All senior accounts must be paid in full by May 1st to participate in graduation.

All students must have US-based health insurance. International students will be added to the school plan and parents will be billed the premium. Domestic students must provide their own insurance. They cannot be added to the school plan.
