

SCHEDULE OF TUITION PLANS AND FEES 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

Tuition is \$22,500 for Upper School Day Students. Tuition may be paid in one of three ways, as listed below. The **non-refundable** enrollment deposit is equal to 10% of net tuition (\$1,500 minimum) and must be returned with the signed Enrollment Agreement.

- The **Instructional Materials Fee** covers science lab fees, visual art materials, and performing arts fees. This does not include any fees itemized below. Ake
- The **Health Center Fee** covers your daughter's health needs while at School. We have a state-certified infirmary staffed by a registered nurse and a physician who is on call twenty-four hours a day. Medications, private doctors' bills and hospitalization are not covered by



the Health Center Fee. Those costs must be covered under the student's U.S.-based medical health insurance plan, purchased privately or through the School.

- The **Activity Fee/Yearbook** covers on-campus weekend activities and entertainment for all students throughout the year. Tickets and transportation to off-campus events, movies, shopping, etc. are charges incurred by each student. Yearbooks are provided to all students.
- The **Technology Fee** provides access to a dorm wireless network with time limits by grade level. Computers are available in the library and labs for academic use. Students are required to use school-provided virus protection on personal computers. Limited troubleshooting is provided by the Tech Department, but computer repairs are the responsibility of the family. All students are required to own a personal iPad for in-class use.
- The **Dorm Room Security Deposit** covers damages to the room beyond normal wear and tear and is returned at the end of the school year if there are no damages or extra cleaning required.

UPPER SCHOOL:

- International Baccalaureate Fees (based on 2019-20)

 - Subject Exam Fee \$119.00 (per subject)

MIDDLE SCHOOL AND UPPER SCHOOL:

- Academic Skills/Support \$750-\$2,250.00 per trimester
- Subject-specific tutoring \$75.00 per session
- Private music instruction \$40.00 per lesson

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES AND BILLING PROCEDURES

1) Parents will receive a monthly tuition statement with itemized tuition and fees. Balances are due and payable when statements are received. A late charge of 1.5% will accrue on any balance more than 30 days past due.

2) Each student also maintains a separate debit account (Smart Account) in the school store with an initial deposit of \$250 for day students to cover e-books, textbooks and incidental expenses incurred throughout the year. Funds must be in the account for students to cover cash withdrawals and store purchases, including e-books and textbooks.

3) FACTS Payment Plan: There is an enrollment fee of \$40 and late fees will be assessed on any delinquent installment payments.
